# Message indicator

The message indicator on the handset can indicate unit status, as explained below.

## Setting the message indicator

You can enable and disable the message indicator for each type of status.

- "Incoming call" (default: On)
- "New message" (default: On)
- "New VM" (default: On)
- "Missed call" (default: Off)
- "Alarm" (default: On) (handset only)

This feature can be set for each unit.

- 1 For handset: [MENU]#278
- 2 (\$): Select the desired setting and press [SELECT].
  - "✓" is displayed next to enabled items.
  - To disable an item, select it and press [SELECT] again. "✓" disappears.
- 3 [SAVE]  $\rightarrow$  [OFF]

#### Note:

 If the message indicator flashes when the handset is not placed on the base unit, the handset consumes battery power faster than usual.
