


AirPlay function allows you to stream music wirelessly from an iOS device, such as iPhone or iPod touch to the speakers of SC-HC57.

To use the AirPlay function, SC-HC57 must join the same wireless network as the iOS device through the wireless network router (access point).





If the AirPlay " icon is not displayed, try:

- Restarting the wireless network router.

- Restarting the iOS device (iPhone/iPod touch/iPad).

- On the iOS device, turn the Wi-Fi® setting off and on again.

FAQ

I have a new iOS device (iPhone/iPod touch/iPad), do I need to reset SC-HC57? No. you only have to connect the new iOS device to the same home wireless network (Refer to "Using AirPlay")

My wireless network router is WPS push button compatible but SC-HC57 does not light blue with "METHOD 1".

The security setting may be set to WEP. Try using "METHOD 2".

Can I change the display name for SC-HC57 (e.g., HC57_Bedroom)? Yes, refer to the Operating Instructions "Network settings", under "AirPlay".
