Windows 10, Windows 11


Driver installation procedures

Explain the example in Windows 11.


1. Please unzip the distributed file “technics_audio_player_win_ *_*_*.zip” (“*” stands for a numeric character.) by right clicking it and selecting ‘Extract All...’, or by using another extraction method.
2. Double-click the Technics_USB_Audio.exe file in the folder that opened in step 1 to open the installation wizard.

If a software use confirmation pop-up dialog opens, click [Run] or [Yes] to continue with installation of the driver file.


3. Choose Setup Language, and Click [Next].




4. Click [Next].



5. Please read the contents of the License Agreement. If you agree to the terms, select “I accept the terms in the license agreement” and then click [Install].




6. When the wizard completion dialog is displayed, click [Finish] to complete the installation.



Connecting to a computer

The first time the unit is connected to one of the computer's USB ports, the driver will be detected automatically.

If the connected unit is recognized properly, the Technics USB Audio device will have been added as a playback device in Windows Sound Control Panel.



Music playback software settings

To output audio from music playback software from this unit when connected to a computer by USB, set the sound playback device to [Technics USB Audio] in the settings of the software that you are using. See the instructions for that software for details about how to set the sound playback device.

If you only want the sound from specific software to be output from this unit, select [Technics USB Audio] in the settings of that software, but do not set [Technics USB Audio] as the Default Device for sound playback in the Windows Sound Control Panel.
