

STEP 1. Check the current firmware version

Panasonic recommends that you update the firmware in your SC-C30 if the firmware version indicated is older than the version being offered. Please check the current version of firmware in the following steps.

1. Press and hold [•DIMMER/-INFO] to display the network status or settings.
2. Press [•DIMMER/-INFO] repeatedly to display “F/W Ver.”.

If the firmware version indicated is earlier than the "F/W Ver. 1.01.16.00", please update the unit's firmware.

STEP 2. Download the updated version of the firmware.

Download of any file for Panasonic firmware update requires your agreement with the software agreement. You may proceed to the next step only once you have agreed. Please make sure to confirm all terms and conditions in advance to proceed to download.

License Agreement

IMPORTANT-READ CAREFULLY: This LICENSE AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") is a legal AGREEMENT between you, a lawful possessor of certain Panasonic product which is SC-C30 ("Product"), who will be referred to in this AGREEMENT as "Customer" and Panasonic Corporation ("Panasonic") for the use of the Software (defined in Article 1) and this website ("Website").

Article 1 License

Customer is granted the right to download, install and use one copy of the firmware provided through the Website ("Software") on a single Product but only for installation and use in the designated area (if any) of indicated Products. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, Panasonic AND ANY OF ITS AFFILIATED COMPANIES DISCLAIM ALL WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE AND

NON-INFRINGEMENT, WITH REGARD TO THE SOFTWARE AND WEBSITE. Procedure of downloading

Please download the firmware and extract the file in the following steps.

1. Make a temporary folder on your PC for downloading the file.
2. Click the following “download” and save the firmware in the folder you created in the above step.

3. Extract downloaded file.
 - Double click the download file or use extract software depending on your PC setting.
4. The extracted file SC-C30.swu should be 150,104,640 bytes. If the file size is not the same, please download and extract the file again.
5. Copy SC-C30.swu to the root folder of the USB flash memory.
